**First of all, a word of thanks to all of you who make our Sunday and weekday services such a wonderful experience here at Bishop Cronyn.**


**Altar Guild:** **NEW** There are no weekday services until September. ON SUNDAY please put out only the silver dish with the red glass liner with the bread in it. Place the bread directly into the red glass liner and cover with one of the bread clothes or a purificator. The bread cloths are wearing and it is much easier for clergy to clean the vessels after communion using only the silver dish and red liner. These come apart to form two vessels for the administration of communion. Thanks!

**Readers/Intercessors:** **NEW** The Readings and Prayers of the people are now being read from the lectern. We have adjusted the P.A. system so that it is working much better than in the past

and the slightly elevated position of the lectern helps the transmission of sound. When reading, imagine that you are bouncing your voice off the back wall of the choir gallery. Allow some time of silence (perhaps 30 seconds) after each reading for reflection. During the summer months if all the readers could look the readings over before each Sunday and if someone is not present to read, be prepared to fill in. Thanks!

**Greeters:**  Because there are now several other activities in the church at times other than Sunday, the hymn books and service books are kept at the back of the church. On Sunday only the liturgy booklets, Sunday handouts and a hymn book are needed. A note in the liturgy book will remind the congregation to return their books to the back of the church after service. Thanks!

**Duty Wardens:**  The P.A. system distracts during the 9 a.m. service so it needs to be turned on before the 10:30 liturgy. Be sure to turn on the amplifier, both of the transmitters and the microphone on the lectern. To save on batteries be sure the mic on the lectern is turned off after the liturgy. Thanks!

**Servers / Sub-deacons / Deacons:**  These ministries have been assigned over the summer months, but realizing that vacation and travel gets in the way sometimes, please arrange for a replacement. If you are in church on Sunday, check with the presiding priest to see if you are needed. If someone is away without notice please fill in as needed.

*To all members of the ministry team: When we have visiting musicians who play before the service, please keep conversations to a minimum and when necessary to talk, do so in a low voice. These musicians come to us to offer a gift of their talent. Attentiveness to the music will both respect that offering and encourage them to come again. Thanks*
